Paul Chapin is the president and CEO of Goodwill, The Amity Group, headquartered in Hamilton, Ontario, Canada. A member of the Goodwill Industries International Board of Directors since 2007, he served as chair of the 2010–2011 Conference of Executives.

Chapin completed his undergraduate degree in computer science at McMaster University in Hamilton prior to completing his master's degree in health administration at the University of Ottawa, and his master's degree in business administration at York University in Toronto.

Before joining Goodwill<sup>®</sup> in 1999, Chapin had an extensive career serving as president and CEO of several hospitals across Canada. He was active professionally during this period, serving as chair of the British Columbia Health Association, as president of the Health Administrators Association of British Columbia, and as chair of many industry committees.

An active volunteer, Chapin currently serves as the board chair of St. Peter's Care Centres, a not-for-profit nursing home, and as the board vice chair of the Hamilton Health Sciences Corporation, a large teaching hospital complex that includes six hospitals and a cancer centre.

Chapin has previously served as board chair of the Board for the United Way of Burlington and Greater Hamilton; as board chair of a community college; and as board vice chair of a Crippled Children's Centre. He was an active Rotary member for 27 years, during which time he served as the president of three different Rotary clubs, held the position of assistant district governor, was named Rotarian of the Year and became a multiple Paul Harris Fellow.
